A Call to Confession (Responsively):

Approach the throne of mercy. Seated upon it is the God of glory whose love is everlasting.

God is faithful, slow to anger, and rich with love abundant toward all who sin and fall short of their own expectations and God's.

Prayer of Confession (Unison):

God of glory, who is more wonderful than we have dared to imagine or can imagine, we confess our share in the selfishness that rules on this human plane and our readiness to love the lesser goods that – while not bad in and of themselves – are not the highest and the best that can be found in loving you with heart and soul and mind and strength. We confess also to the ignorance of not knowing the error of our ways and to the almost callousness of not caring about the error of our ways. We appeal to the cross of Jesus Christ and its promise of redemption and renewal. Amen.

All your ways with us, O God, all your ways are ways of steadfast love and faithfulness. We respond gratefully and with faithfulness our own.
